

ABI PRIVACY POLICY

ABI is committed to maintaining your confidence and trust as it relates to the privacy and usage of your information. Please read below and learn how we collect, protect, share, and use your information as part of our technology platforms and all our products and services.

Information We Collect

Personally Identifiable Information: We collect personally identifiable information that can identify you, such as your name, address, telephone number, mobile number, email address, and Social Security Number (collectively, "Personally Identifiable Information" or "PII"). PII could also be information you provide on others, such as business partners.

How We Collect Information

- a. **Information provided by you:** Information is collected from you when you enter information in connection with an inquiry into our services. This information could be provided via an online form, over the phone, or via other means in which you interact with our services.
- b. **Information from service providers:** Information is collected from third-party service providers, such as credit bureaus and service providers who may have data on your financial profile, home, or other demographic information.
- c. **Information from cookies and other tracking technologies:** Like many websites, we use cookies, web beacons, and similar technologies to record your preferences, to track the use of our Site and collect Information. This information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and/or clickstream data. We may combine this automatically-collected log information with other information we collect about you. You may choose to set your web browser to refuse cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you do so, please note that some parts of our Site may not function properly.

How We Protect Your Information

a. We take what we believe to be industry-standard security measures (including physical, electronic, and procedural measures) to help safeguard your Information from unauthorized access and disclosure. We also require employees to comply with information security safeguards; we use encryption in the transmission of your Information between your system and ours; we use firewalls and other intrusion detection and prevention control system to help prevent unauthorized persons from gaining access to your Information. No system can be completely secure. Therefore, although we take steps to secure your information, we cannot guarantee that your Information, searches, or other communication will always remain secure.

In such cases, we may raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us.

d. When we believe disclosure is appropriate in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding actual or suspected illegal activity or other wrongdoing; to protect and defend the rights, property, or safety of ABI, our users, our employees, or others; or to enforce our Site's terms and condition or other agreements or policies.
